His job duties are different from mine. Below are the four areas that need coverage. This could be done by either a single overall coordinator or several coordinators or small team to see these areas are covered. You would work hand in hand with Johnny.

At Game Night:

Need one or two adults to help with 6:00 PM set-up at Game Club. Just supervise, the Teens do the set up of equipment. The adults can put up the signs over the doors and at the Teen hall entrance upstairs.

Need one or two adults to help collect and supervise the Teens with the clean-up in the food room at Game Club at 9:40 PM. This is our community service for the space to have Teen Club at the church.

Teen Club in Portland: Bring the equipment to Tabor Heights Methodist Church. The Teens set up and organize the rooms. Work with Johnny to bring cooperative activities and people the teens are interested in meeting.

Teens Away: Find out what type of activities the teens would like to do or participate in out in the community. Ideas come from mainly the teens and sometime you and Johnny plan Away activities. This can be one person or several people. Currently this is covered through October.

Teen Club Representatives to the PAN Board: There needs to be an representative to serve as a Member at Large position. Alex has a new work schedule and can no longer work serve as the teens representative (see below).

I will be available to help and will come to those activities my schedule will allow. Additionally, Alex has a new work schedule, he is planning on returning to college and can no longer serve PAN.
